1-1 support for children and young people who are high risk victims of domestic abuse.
Support is offered in school or community venues. Safety planning and advocacy, court support for 3-16year olds

Young Person Group and 1-1

1-1 sessions and 8 week STAR group for 11-13 and 14-17 year olds who have experienced domestic abuse in their family or in their own relationships.

Healthy Relationship workshops for all young people delivered in school and youth clubs.







Heart to Heart



Heart-to-heart is a fun and effective early help attachment programme for parents/carers and their children/teens to attend together.

A 6 week group for 5-9 years and 10-13 years to attend with their parent/carer.

Child Parent Relationship Therapy Group

A 10 week group, for parents/ carers, which aims to strengthen their relationship with their child through play.

CPRT teaches parent/carers to work in a therapeutic manner with their children through instruction, demonstration of play sessions and at home play sessions.









Offers support for children and young people aged 3-17 years old who have been affected by domestic abuse together with their parent/carers who live in the Merthyr area.

The children must not be living with the perpetrator to access support, unless they are engaging in a perpetrator programme.


